11. QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC ON ITEMS LISTED ON TONIGHT'S AGENDA AND ANY OTHER TOPIC OF CONCERN

- ♦ Several members of the audience spoke about the good work done by Mrs. Ann Marie Bruder and her Child Study Team leadership as well as how she helped individual students. An inquiry was also made as to how the Board is preparing for hiring a Business Administrator, Superintendent, High School Principal as well as organizing for a referendum in the near future.
- ♦ In response to a question from Mrs. Capalbo regarding hiring of an instructional supervisor, it was stated that resolution #6P is being pulled.
- ♦ Mrs. Nancy Stern spoke about legislation to remove Superintendent salary caps and asked if the board is considering a similar resolution. She also spoke about the issue of funding Charter Schools and if the board will be addressing that issue. She reminded the Board that these are issues that should be discussed by the Board in public sessions. Mr. Yusang Park responded that the board would be addressing these issues.
- ♦ In response to a question if there is an executed contract and separation agreement with the former Business Administrator, it was stated that there are executed agreements.
- ♦ Closing School 6Election Day was also brought up and it was noted that schools were always closed up until last year. It was reported that the County has asked the school district to close on Election Day.
- ♦ A question was raised about a legal ad for financing temporary classrooms and the bid opening.
- ♦ Another person raised a question as to why Board members who attended a conference did not give a report.
- ♦ In response to a question as to why modular classrooms were not placed at the High School like Northern Valley did, Mr. Saxton explained that the pre-school program needs integration with the elementary program at School #2.
