- 1. The Regular Business Meeting was called to order at 8:00 PM by Mr. David Sarnoff, President of the Fort Lee Board of Education.

#### 5. REPORT OF THE INTERIM SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

- Report of School Security Drills for the month of March 2015 was made available.
- Mr. Paul Saxton announced that the Fort Leader achieved first place in the American Scholastic Press Association competition. The competition involved over 300 schools.
- Sophie Karobatsos, Fort Leader advisor was recognized. Mr. David Sarnoff then presented certificates to all students involved.
- Senior Bernadette Darcy was recognized for receiving Honorable Mention Award from Alliance for Young Artists and Writers for her essay and poem.
- Mr. Paul Saxton introduced discussion of the proposed 2015-2016 budget. He identified various items that were eliminated from the budget that totaled approximately \$826,000.
- The cuts included several Central Office positions, teacher positions, a principal and Church of the Good Shepherd rental among other items.
- Mr. Paul Saxton and Mr. David Rinderknecht then reviewed the budget using a PowerPoint presentation. It was noted that \$30,000 had been reallocated from supplies to fund AP exams and the Debt Service Budget was reduced because Bonds were sold and we now have an exact amount that is due for bond payment in 2015-2016.
- A question and answer period followed as part of the Public Hearing. A question was raised as to how much of the budget is the result of State mandated programs.
